Annual Report

The present intake of GTC is 2106 overall including B.Tech, M.Tech and M.B.A Program and Ph.D programs Approved by RTU. The journey started with 240 students & presently 2300 students are studying in the Campus.

This is the matter of pride that Computer Science Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering program of GIT are accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) which ensures highest degree of credibility in assurance of quality and relevance of Professional and Technical Education imparted by the Accredited Engineering program. The Institute has also been accredited by Institution of Engineers, Computer Society of India.

The another feather in cap of GIT is being Ranked 4th among all Institutes in Rajasthan by RTU, Kota The quiver of Global Technical Campus is full of achievements after achievements piling on. The Global Institute of Technology has received Outstanding Institution Award by NITTTR, a unit of MHRD, Government of India Rajasthan Education Excellence Award – 2017 and IAB Blind Empowerment champions Silve Zone Award-2017 for the empowerment of visual challenged.
