
Welcome Note:

Sr. No.	AGENDA	DISCUSSIONS
1.	Review of ongoing research projects.	Ongoing projects were delayed due to COVID restrictions, delayed data collection, and difficulty in accessing labs. Faculty expressed need for flexible timelines.
2.	Strengthening faculty publication quality.	Several faculty published papers in paid/low-quality journals. Committee emphasised avoiding predatory journals and encouraged submissions to SCOPUS/SCI.
3.	Formation of student research groups.	Student involvement in research is minimal. Students often hesitate due to lack of guidance, so committee suggested forming structured student groups under faculty mentors.
4.	Planning for FDPs and workshops.	Need for FDP on Research Methodology, "How to Write a Research Paper," and "How to Use Research Tools."
5.	Any other point to discuss with permission of chair.	No other point to discuss.
